

Helmet Standard Labels

In the October edition of Scrutineers Bulletin distributed last week we ran an article about suspected fraudulent British Standard labels with the serial number being the same on a number of labels. We ended the article with the statement that "SNELL labels are not uniquely numbered but the same label checks will generally highlight forgeries"

This is incorrect, SNELL labels are individually and uniquely numbered with a serial number. This serial number is printed along the bottom edge of the label underneath the standard number (shown as ### SAMPLE ### on the example below). As with the British Standard label this serial number allows checks to be made into which manufacturer and when the label was issued.
